





# Ventia Rally of Dargaville Tunatahi 27th July 2024

## **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE:**

1. This event is a National Rally with foreign participation, promoted by Auckland Car Club, Hibiscus Coast Motorsport Club, Northern Sports Car Club and will take place on 27 July 2024 in the Kaipara District area. The rally will be based in Dargaville and will consist of 8 Stages of approximately 130 km of gravel roads and will be Round 3 of the 2024 GRS North Island Rally Series. The event will be run on public roads in the Kaipara District region with a Service Park based in central Dargaville.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

The MotorSport NZ Permit Numbers are: National TBC and Clubmans TBC.

#### 3. THE EVENT

Dargaville

**3.1 Venue:** The event starts and finishes in Dargaville and will be run on gravel roads in the Kaipara District.

3.2 Length: The National field will compete 8 stages, comprising 127km of special stages and 192km of touring. The Clubmans field will compete 4 stages, comprising 77km of special stages and 140km of touring. A full stage description is appended to these regulations.

**3.3** First Car Starts: National Field from TC0, 6 Hokianga Road, Dargaville at 0900hrs.

Clubmans Field from TC4C at 1251hrs approx

**3.4 First Car Finishes:** At (approx) 1729hrs at the final control TC8A which is situated at 21 Totara Street, Dargaville.

## 4. ENTRIES

- **4.1** For the purpose of entry, those competing in the Ventia Rally of Dargaville Tunatahi are national competitors. Those competing in the Ventia Rally of Dargaville Tunatahi Clubmans event are clubmans competitors.
- **4.2** Entries should be made through the MotorSport Online system (<a href="https://online.motorsport.org.nz">https://online.motorsport.org.nz</a>). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

Entries will be accepted in the following priority, provided competitors have supplied a completed online entry **and paid their entry fee** by the close of normal entries **(12 July 2024)**.

- · Competitors that are registered for the 2024 GRS North Island Rally Series (Rally Te Ika-a Māui)
- · Clubmans competitors as defined by the competitor's entry form.
- · All other competitors.

# **4.3** Opening and Closing: These open with the publication of these regulations and close at 1700hrs on 12 July 2024.

Entries post marked after the normal closing date but received prior to 1700hrs on 19 July 2024 will be subject to the late fee.

#### 4.4 Fees:

## (1) Competing vehicle:

Entry Fee Foreign Participation \$995 including GST.

Entry Fee National \$995 including GST.

Entry Fee Clubmans \$695 including GST.

## (2) Other:

Late Entry Fee \$200 including GST.

Registration for each additional service crew \$20 including GST.

Change of competition crew member \$20 including GST.

Additional road book \$20 including GST.

PLEASE NOTE: If you wish to have extra service vehicles, please add the required fee to your entry fee when making payment. Only identified service vehicles will be permitted in remote fuel zones and the service park.

Please use the MotorSport Online "SP" code number, "Rally" and #1 Driver Name as reference when making payment.

The entry fee includes:

- One road book
- 2 Route maps
- 1 Service vehicle windscreen number this must be affixed to the vehicle before admittance to the Service Park
- Vehicle Livery Pack
- Rallysafe Fee
- \$20 contribution to native tree planting in the Kaipara District as an environmental sustainability investment.

## 4.5 Withdrawal and Refund Policy

Any competitor who withdraws from the event after 12 July 2024, but prior to 1700hrs on 19 July 2024 will forfeit 25% of their entry fee.

Any competitor who withdraws from the event later than 1700hrs on 19 July 2024, will forfeit 50% of their entry fee.

Any competitor who withdraws after the start of documentation will forfeit 100% of their entry fee.

## 4.6 Number of Starters:

The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 40 entries are received at normal closing date.

## 4.7 Acceptance of Entry:

These will be notified on 17 July 2024 together with the seeded start list.

## 4.8 Competitor Requirements:

- (1) Knowledge and Understandings: In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. Particularly, The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitor's obligations, and Appendix Three Schedule R articles pertaining to Stage notes, Pace notes and Reconnaissance.
- (2) Licence Requirements: Both the No. 1 and No. 2 drivers shall hold a R Grade or higher MotorSport NZ issued Competition Licence.
  - If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.
- (3) New Competitors: Any driver(s) who have not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend the new competitor special briefing.

#### 5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

- **5.1 Compliance:** All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A and Appendix Three Schedule R of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.
- **5.2 Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:
  - A 0-1300cc 2wd
  - B 1301-1600cc 2wd
  - C 1601-2000cc 2wd
  - D 2001cc and over 2wd
  - E Classic 2wd
  - F 1601-1999cc (AP4/R5) 4wd
  - G 2000cc and over 4wd
  - H Subaru H6
  - I Pre 96 4wd

**NOTE: Competitors may only enter one class** 

This event has a special focus on Clubmans competitors. To support this initiative, there will be trophies for the  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  placed Clubmans Driver and Co-driver.

## 6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material. We request that those competitors that reside near to Auckland present themselves to documentation on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> July.

The time and venue for this will be:

Thursday 25 July, 1930hrs, Auckland Car Club, 44 Stoddard Road, Mt Roskill, Auckland.

Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July, 1700hrs, Northern Wairoa Boating Club, 21 Totara Street, Dargaville.

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> July, 1100-1115 hrs, Northern Wairoa Boating Club, 21 Totara Street, Dargaville for Clubmans competitors only.

Any competitor that has not completed a remote safety audit prior to the event must contact Dave Robb, Chief Scrutineer prior to the event, to arrange on-event auditing.

Cars will not be cleared to compete until all of their competition numbers and advertising requirements are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.

#### 6.1 REMOTE SAFETY AUDIT

Competitors are requested to arrange, with one of the scrutineers on the list below, a safety audit within the two weeks prior to the event. Inspections must be carried out between 5 and 19 July 2024.

## 9. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

The official noticeboard will be ChrisSport.

## 10. RESULTS

Provisional results will be posted at 1815hrs on 27 July 2024

## 11. STAGE NOTES

The use of Stage Notes will be permitted in accordance with Schedule R Part 1, Article 7.1. For those competitors wishing to purchase the Stage Notes it is essential that they advise of their intention on the box provided on the entry form.

NIRS Competitors: \$160

NZRC and other competitors: \$290

## 12. STARTING SYSTEM FOR SPECIAL STAGES

The competitors start time will be allocated at the start line by the Start Marshal using the Rallysafe system.

The countdown will be provided in the car via the Rallysafe in car display.

## 13. TIME CARDS.

The event will be using Method 1 as per Schedule R, Article 12.5 (1).

Timecards will be issued to national competitors at TCO and to Clubman's competitors at TC4C. Each crew is responsible for their timecard which must be carried in the competing vehicle throughout the rally and must be presented to all Controls by a member of the crew for time recording or endorsing.

At the Finish Stop Control, crews are required to come to a complete stop. This is to allow the timing crew to complete the timecards and to check with competitors in case of emergency.

## 14. GENERAL

## A. Fuel:

Competitors are reminded to ensure they are familiar with the <u>MotorSport NZ Code of Practice – Fuel Handling</u>.

Refuelling in the Service Park is prohibited.

All competitors will have two opportunities to refuel outside the service area:

(1) Before Service B at 65 Murdoch Street, Dargaville

(2) After Service C, Kaipara Kumara Ltd, Ruawai, prior to SS7 Details are in the road book.

## B. Promotional Requirements, Ceremonial Start Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> July

All national competitors (as defined in Article 4.1 of these Supplementary Regulations) must be in their allocated position within the Starting area with their cars by 0830hrs. National competitors must ensure their service crew and vehicle are in the Service Park by 0800hrs.

The Ceremonial Start formalities will also occur during this time.

Clubmans competitors must ensure their service crew is in the Service Park by 1100hrs on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> July.

All crews are instructed to enter the Service Park from the Totara Street end by Woolworth/BP.

National competitors must report to TCO and Clubman's competitors must report to TC4C, twenty minutes before their due start time.

## C. Change of Codriver

Change of Co-Driver is permitted at any Service; the replacement Co-Driver must have completed all Documentation and Scrutineering requirements. Competitors wishing to take this option are to advise the Clerk of the Course via a CRO at the Service Park at least 15mins before leaving service. Competitors wishing to make this change are advised as per the current MSNZ Manual the crew undertaking the change cannot feature in the results and will be deemed to be disqualified.

## D. Official Time

Official time throughout the entire rally will be set from Rallysafe.

## E. Withdrawals and Re-joining

All withdrawals either temporarily or permanent must be reported to Rally Control as soon as possible. Competitors who have handed in a temporary withdrawal form or have phoned a temporary withdrawal to Rally Headquarters, have the opportunity to re-join the rally.

Competitors wishing to re-join may do so at TC2C, TC4C and TC6B by presenting a re-join form to the CRO or Stage Post Chief. Re-joining competitors will be reseeded at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

The organisers require cars that have suffered accident damage to be checked and cleared by the Chief Scrutineer or his appointed assistant prior to re-joining the event.

No competitor will be permitted to restart the rally once they have handed in a "Final Withdrawal" form.

#### F. Servicing

Servicing is restricted to the following service parks located at the Parenga and Totara Street Car Park in Dargaville; and in Ruawai. Competitors must service on a ground sheet capable of holding the debris and mud that falls from the vehicle during servicing and ensure that all rubbish is removed when leaving the service park areas.

Service Park information will be distributed with the Supplementary Regulations Part Two - Acceptance of Entry. Competitors who wish to share service crews, or with large trucks and service vehicles, are requested to make an application to martyroestenburgnz@gmail.com, with details and dimensions of the extra space required. This application is to be made at the time of entry.

There are toilets provided within the Dargaville Service Park and the Ruawai Service.

## G. Early Entry to a TC

Early entry is permitted at TC8A. Competitors may be invited in early at other time controls.

#### H. Prizegiving

The prizegiving will occur at the Northern Wairoa Boating Club, Totara Street as soon as results are final.

#### I. Rallysafe

The Rallysafe tracking and timing technology will be used by all competitors. An overview of the system which provides significant safety benefits can be found on <a href="https://www.rallysafe.com.au">www.rallysafe.com.au</a>.

The cost to competitors will be in two parts:

- (a) A 'one off' cost of approximately \$200 to purchase the wiring kit, brackets and aerials that can be used at multiple events. This must be purchased from Rallysafe direct see https://shop.statusas.com/shop/category/rallysafe/. Novices, if you have any questions regarding Rallysafe, do not hesitate to contact the organisers. We are here to help.
- (b) An event cost (for all competitors) of \$154 is included in the entry fee.

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## Appendix 1: Stage Descriptions

Stages 1 & 3 Waihue 8.6kms

Medium to fast gravel road with a hard base.

Stages 2 & 4 Opanake 16.6kms Starts fast to 90 left at spectator point, then medium nicely cambered road, hard base if dry with flowing corners tightening through trees before opening out to finish.

## Stages 5 & 7 Tokatoka 19kms

Enjoy parts of previous WRC stages, medium to fast packed gravel roads. A couple of slumps in the road and narrow bridges. Fast, undulating roads to finish.

## Stages 6 & 8 Greenhill 19.9km


Starts fast before turning right onto the infamous Oparakau Road. Sweeping cambered corners to finish before SH12.




